Safety Personal safety - Gear, knowledge, physical ability, leadership of skipper, teamwork, health

Boat Safety Dinghy and going ashore – lifejackets, torches, radios Craft safety. Seacheck.- lifeboats

Distress See flares – handheld, parachute, smoke. White, Red VHF Radio and other safety equipment.
