ICC – International Certificate of Competence

SailCork is a Recognised Test Centre (*Sail and Power*) for the **ISA** (*Irish Sailing Association*) **I.C.C.** (*International Certificate of Competence*). This is the usual minimum requirement for chartering in the Mediterranean area - Croatia, Greece, Turkey, France and Spain and the Caribbean. The aim of the ICC is to provide boat owners and people wishing to charter boats with an internationally recognised document certifying their competence to skipper a boat for recreational use.

Applicants must be resident in the Republic of Ireland and be over 16 years of age. There are a number of ways to get the Cert.:-

- **1.** If you already hold an **ISA Day Skipper** Practical Cert. (or higher – ie Yachtmaster Coastal Skipper or Yachtmaster Offshore), *apply directly to the ISA for a conversion Cert.*
- **2.** If you **attend a 5 day course** (or 3 w/e) (Practical Day Skipper or higher) with SailCork, on successful completion you can convert your new Cert. to an I.C.C. through the ISA.
- **3.** If you have reasonable recent boating experience with a Shorebased Navigation Course Cert, you can do a **1 day assessment** at SailCork.
- **4.** If you have a lot of boating experience but no navigational Cert, you can do a **2 day assessment** at SailCork.
